LIRR Travel Tips & Ways to Save

- **Groups** - Groups of 30 or more can save with [LIRR Group Rates](#), however smaller groups (15 or more) may also save by paying this rate for 30 people. Call (718) 217 -5477 and say "Group Travel" to make a reservation.
- **Smaller Groups** - Adults can save with [LIRR Off-Peak Ten Trip tickets](#) (10 one ways), which offer 15% off fares, and can be shared. These tickets are good for six months..
- **Children** - The LIRR Family Fare allows up to four children, ages 5-11, to travel for 75 cents each way on off-peak trains when accompanied by an adult; children under 5 ride free.
- **Seniors** - Individuals 65 years of age or older save 50% off the peak fare. Valid all times except weekday morning peak (westbound) trains. Customers must have Medicare card, driver's license, birth certificate, or [MTA Reduced-Fare MetroCard](#) available to present at time of ticket purchase or use. Sold as an option under "One Way" or "Round Trip" ticket buttons on Ticket Machines.
- **CityTicket - CityTicket** is a special \$3.75 fare for travel between two New York City stations on LIRR trains on Saturdays/Sundays.
- **Buy Online in Advance** - Convenient, purchase tickets on-line through our [WebTicket](#) program and receive your tickets in the mail within 3-5 business days.
- **MetroCards** are good for travel on Long Island Bus and NYC Subway and Buses: \$4.50 can be purchased with LIRR tickets at most sale locations; \$20 Metrocards that can be shared and passed back for up to 4 people at subway turnstiles.
- LIRR one-way and round-trip ticket types are valid for 14 days from date of sale; refunds are subject to a \$10 processing.

Regional Travel Information

- **AirTrain** travel is available from JFK to Jamaica Station. Special \$5 MetroCards are sold there and at LIRR [AirTrain Ticket Machines](#) (green).
